A community approach to dog bite prevention

Dog nuisance is a community-based issue that can be managed with the active involvement of every section of the community.

- 1) Keep your locality neat and clean.
- 2) Restaurants, food shops, hotels, residents, etc. are advised to use the Srinagar Municipal Corporation waste pick-up service.
- 3) Poultry shop outlets are advised to use the poultry slaughter waste collection service of the Srinagar Municipal Corporation.
- 4) Don't disturb dog that is eating, sleeping or feeding puppies.
- 5) Don't chase, hit, kick or shout at the dogs.
- 6) When you face a growling dog, stand still and don't scream.
- 7) Children of the age group 4-9 years are the most common victims of dog bites; always accompany your children whenever they venture out of home.
- 8) If a dog bites, wash the bite wound with soap and running water for 15 minutes and visit the nearest hospital for treatment.
- 9) If you see a dog in the locality with an abnormal or aggressive behavior with froth dribbling from its mouth; keep away from such dogs and report immediately to Srinagar Municipal Corporation on following help line nos. +911942474499, 1-800-180-7038, +911942470465.
- 10) Citizens are requested to cooperate and coordinate with the Srinagar Municipal Corporation for implementation of Animal Birth Control and Anti Rabies Vaccination (ABC/ARV) Programme in which stray dog will be caught, sterilized and vaccinated against Rabies and then released back to the pickup location.
